# Plein Air painting weekends: Nothing beats going outside to paint in nature!

We have scheduled two weekends for intermediate to advanced painters to

enjoy this summer & fall. You should have some experience with your media of choice to enroll in these weekends, but no experience painting outside is necessary since a complete supply list will be provide prior to each event. The home base will be Creative Catalyst Studio if weather doesn't co-operate, but we will meet at a different location in the greater Cincinnati area when it does.
